You can count on receiving a fresh, timely new program for airing each weekend. We have never missed a week and, Lord willing, we never will. You can receive the program in the manner that's most convenient for your operation, from these options.

FTP STANDARD

FTP (Standard)

This is the standard FTP availability as used for many syndicated broadcasts. We provide you with *unique* sign-in credentials and you can download the program from our server anytime after about 8 a.m. on Monday morning for the following weekend. Each of the program's eight segments (four per hour) is provided as a separate file. The system can be used with any FTP-based file acquisition system (including the popular AMB-OS system) or standard FTP clients such as *FileZilla*. Automated downloads are possible if your system can initiate that. Using an internet browser to download is also supported, if needed, but is *not recommended*. All of our standard file types* are available.

FTP DELIVERED

FTP Delivered

This unique system is for any station that has its own FTP server. You simply provide us with a URL, username and password (created by you on your server) and each week we will automatically deliver the program to your server. You don't even have to download. The files are just...*there!* All of our normal file types* are available in this system. The "FTP Delivered" system's automated uploads to your server are normally done at night.



Heritage DigiDelivery Downloads

This system sends you an email each Monday morning with a special download key. Click on the key, your computer connects to the Digi server, you tell it where to save the files on your system, and the entire program downloads to that destination. Again, all of our usual file types* are available. CD Delivery In The Mail

Yes, we still do that, if that is the only way you can take the program. We mail the program to you each week on two CDs, one for each hour. Segments are "cut tight" to avoid any dead air before or after segments. Each segment of the program (four per hour) is a separate cut on the CD. The Hour 2 CD includes a 5th cut, which is a promo that can be used through the week for the following weekend's program. Each program delivery includes a printed cue/timing/music sheet. (*For non-USA stations, due to frequent and extensive delays in the mail, please use one of the download options above.*)



***The Gospel Greats program is presently made available as high-sampling-rate MP3 or MP2 files. WAV files are available on special request (although they are much bigger to download). Both the "Regular" and "Uncut" versions of the program are available as downloads. (See separate information about the two versions available to choose what would be best for your station on the "Format Information" page.) Your access will be set up for the file type and length you initially request. With all downloads, a cue/timing/music sheet is provided as a PDF file.**
